**SACRAMENTO, CA –**  
Governor Newsom announced today that construction has wrapped on the long anticipated high speed rail project, finally connecting his house directly to the French Laundry.  
Though many questioned if the \$120 billion project would ever come to fruition, Newsom proudly declared that he had proved the doubters wrong.
